Club Honors:

- Member = 10 points
- 1 star = 30 points
- 2 stars = 65 points
- Legacy Award - involvement in every show of your high school career
- Varsity Letterman's Jacket - must meet the following requirements:
 - 1) Have earned an award at Competition
 - OR** Have been on cast/crew for UIL OAP for two years
 - OR** Have been on cast/crew for a UIL OAP that advances to regionals
 - 2) Have attended all performances and rehearsals
 - 3) Have punctually arrived for all performances and rehearsals
 - 4) Have remained eligible for all of the events during the current year
- 3 stars = 100 points
- 4 stars = 135 points
- 5 stars = 170 points

Special Notes:

- The points deadline marks the end of a school year. Points earned from May to August count towards the following school year.
- Points from middle school can be counted towards induction. To avoid point inflation and maintain the honorary nature of induction in a high school setting, those points transfer at a halved value. (Ex: 10 middle school points = 5 high school points)
- Points cannot be claimed for both participating in a role (acting or tech) and attending a production for the same show.
- Points cannot be claimed for attending a production if it's part of an SHS field trip. Those points should be counted as 'going on a theatre field trip'.
